### Review

of international events in the field of disaster risk reduction and emergency situations, conducted by the Center, jointly with international, non-governmental organizations, scientific institutions, and their technical and financial support .

With technical and financial support from donor agencies and international organizations from **September 2016 to December In 2025**, the Center organized and held **212 international events, in which 7,337 people** participated, exchanged experiences, gained new knowledge, and improved their skills in the field of disaster risk reduction, emergency prevention and response, including:

- **2694** representatives of government agencies of the Republic of Kazakhstan.
- **693** representatives of state bodies of the KR.
- **950** representatives of government bodies from Central Asian countries and other states.
- **339** representatives of scientific institutions and independent experts.
- **2661** representatives of international and non-governmental organizations.

The topics of the seminars and trainings covered the entire spectrum of issues in the field of disaster risk reduction, prevention and response to natural and man-made emergencies, including information and communication networks, child safety, early warning and monitoring, providing psychological assistance to the affected population, and much more.

- Providing first medical aid to the affected population;
- Information management in large-scale emergencies;
- Data collection, processing and mapping using GIS;
- Coordinated assessment of the needs of the affected population in emergency situations;
- Work of psychologists in emergency situations, psychological support of personnel;
- Core commitments to children in humanitarian operations.
- Airports are prepared for disasters;
- Effective implementation of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction in the Central Asia and Caucasus region;
- Use of unmanned aerial vehicles in search and rescue operations (SRO) and detection of fires in mountainous areas;
- Protecting citizens abroad in times of crisis;
- "Geoinformation systems, mapping and data management" for employees of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Ministry of Emergency Situations of the KR;
