

REGULATIONS
**on the regional register of experts in the field of Civil protection / defence,
disaster risk reduction, and the prevention of and response to emergency situations**

1. The regional register of experts in the field of civil protection / defence, disaster risk reduction, and the prevention of and response to emergency situations (hereinafter referred to as “the regional register of experts”) is established for the purpose of strengthening organizational and practical measures to engage national and international experts in the implementation of regional scientific and technical programmes and projects, the conduct of expert and analytical studies, the development of methodological documents and materials, and the formulation of scientific and technical recommendations on the application of advances in science, technology and innovation in the field of disaster risk reduction, prevention of and response to large-scale and transboundary emergency situations.

2. The regional register of experts shall be composed of national and international experts engaged in expert and analytical activities in the fields of civil protection/civil defence, disaster risk reduction, prevention of and response to emergency situations, fire safety, seismic safety, environmental safety, hydrological and hydrometeorological safety, radiation safety, and other related areas relevant to civil protection/civil defence, disaster risk reduction, and emergency prevention and response.

3. The regional register of experts is intended to address the following main tasks:

- a) enhancing the effectiveness of management decisions taken by authorized authorities, international and non-governmental organizations in the fields of civil protection, disaster risk reduction, and the prevention of and response to emergency situations in the Central Asian countries, through the broad use of the scientific and practical potential of leading scientists, specialists and experts in the conduct of expert and analytical studies;
- b) engaging leading scientists and specialists in the conduct of objective and competent expert and analytical studies in support of the development and implementation of research, experimental design, technological and innovative projects and programmes at the regional and sectoral levels;
- c) providing interested authorized public authorities, international and non-governmental organizations that allocate resources for the implementation of scientific and technical programmes and projects with the opportunity to engage experts from the regional register in expert and analytical activities;
- d) systematizing statistics, analysis and monitoring of the results of expert and analytical activities carried out by experts included in the regional register of experts;
- e) developing proposals and implementing measures aimed at improving the effectiveness of expert and analytical activities in the interests of authorized public authorities, international and non-governmental organizations in the fields of civil protection, disaster risk reduction, and the prevention of and response to emergency situations.

4. The regional register of experts shall be compiled by the Secretariat of the Regional Forum—Meeting of the Heads of Emergency Management Authorities of the Central Asian countries on the basis of recommendations from public authorities, international and non-governmental organizations, and research and educational institutions, in coordination with the emergency management authorities, as well as through an assessment of the scientific, practical and expert experience of candidates nominated for inclusion in the regional register of experts.

5. The regional register of experts shall be an open and publicly accessible document containing, in summarized form, the surnames, given names and patronymics, areas of specialization, contact details and other relevant information of experts, as well as their photographs.

6. More detailed information (curricula vitae) of experts, the results of their activities and other relevant data shall be requested and provided to interested stakeholders by the Secretariat of the Regional Forum—Meeting of the Heads of Emergency Management Authorities of the Central Asian countries, subject to prior consent of the experts concerned.

7. The structural format of the regional register of experts is set out in Annex I.
